Tips for Feedback

- Ask fewer questions, maybe just one or two, instead of many.
- Be curious! Use what or how questions instead of yes/no questions.
- Encourage the student to share their thoughts and opinions about the text.
- Provide feedback that helps the student feel a sense of accomplishment in their reading.
- Offer specific feedback that covers both the overall reading and the details



Show interest and acknowledge the student's effort, not just their skill.

Ask questions and let the student do most of the talking.

Give the student time to think and solve challenges.

Ask questions that help the student progress through the text.
